The weather has been sunny and warm. The course is in perfect condition. With 66 players in the field, Tuscon, Arizona's Krystal Quihuis came from behind today and won the medalist honors for the 87th Women's TRANS National Amateur Golf Championship. She was presented the "Nancy ORR Tournament Medalist Trophy" and the "Agnes Herndon Medalist Pin". Quihuis, a rising junior from the University of Iowa, was the only player in the field to card two sub par rounds, 70-70=140. A close second was Michigan State's Sarah Burnham, whose impressive first round 69 was followed by a 72 placing one shot behind Quihuis.

Sarah Burnham and teammate Katie Sharp together won the "The Howell Cup Team Trophy". This distinctive silver vase is presented to the club or university/college whose two members have the lowest combined two-day score.
