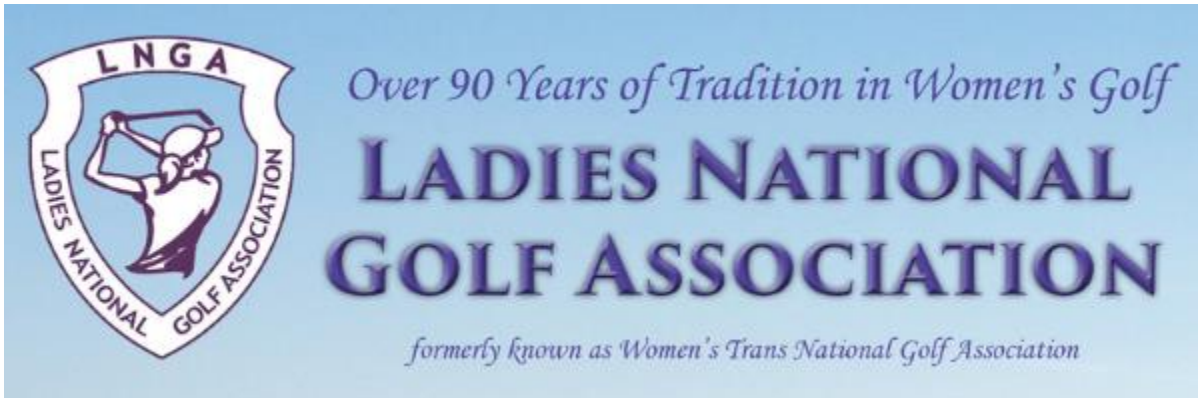

## **LADIES NATIONAL GOLF ASSOCIATION ADDS MID-AMATEUR, SENIOR AMATEUR COMPETITIONS FOR 2021**

The Ladies National Golf Association (LNGA) has added two competitions for the 2021 season.

The inaugural Mid-Amateur and Senior Amateur Championships will be conducted April 19-21 at Anthem Golf & Country Club in Anthem, Ariz. These WAGR-ranked Championships will be conducted concurrently in a 54-hole stroke play format.

“Given today’s changing environment and focus to identify additional amateur championships, it is the right time for the LNGA to transition to independent Mid-Amateur and Senior Amateur Championships, with appropriate yardages and course setups,” said LNGA president Joanne Walker. “We are proud to add these competitions to complement our long-standing LNGA Amateur.”

Entries for the Inaugural Mid-Amateur and Senior Amateur Championships will open February 3 at 9 a.m. EST. Each field is expected to have 60 players, 120 players in total. All contestants will play 36-holes and a cut for the final round will be administered. Detailed information is available at the [LNGA website](#).



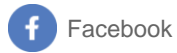
